One day program on Forests for water and wetlands

A one day program was organized in the in the villages of Deewanjot, panchayat Khatponk, Block Tisri, District Giridih, State Jharkhand of India on forest for water and wetlands. In this programme 80 children actively participated in activities that outlined the importance of forest such as; the role of forests in carbon sequestration, hydrological cycling, reducing erosion. We also focused on the current status of environment and the degradation of ecological balances. How we can be helpful in reducing pollution and developing the forest area and formation of Forest management committee and during this discussion session we emphasized on strengthening the forest committee and making information more available to the larger community.

The first activity was to conduct a class for the children to educate them on issues such as ecology, the environment and the importance that water, trees and animals play in daily human life.

The villages of Deewanjot, panchayat Khatponk are very poor and have been subjected to heavy deforestation. The community being targeted belonged to scheduled caste and scheduled tribes and the children have been urged to try and protect the remaining forests for the next generation.
